Randy LaJoie, swept the dust off his Lajoie's Scrap Yard, Harris Trucking, Stock Car Steel, Joie Of Seating & Team Onion Pro-Challenge Monte Carlo for a convincing win at the world's fastest ½ mile of Bristol Motor Speedway. Corey initially set the fastest time to grab the pole position, but had a problem with his fuel after post qualifying inspection which relegated the #7-11 to the rear of the field on race day. After making changes that the officials wanted, Corey was looking forward to starting in the rear so, as he put it: "I could pass some cars".

With the green flag waving and his father in the spotter stand, Shoe started his march to the front, working the high side like a true veteran with poise and patience.



"It must run in the family having bad restarts, as my Dad was never known for having great restarts and I about gave the race away with a real bad one myself, thank god I had another shot at it, plus I had Dad in my ear to get up on the wheel, which I was able to do", Corey explained from victory lane.

"Winning here is great, it's cool to win at a place Dad never did so for right now, I've got one up on him. But, I know I've got a long way to go to accomplish what he's done, but it's still exciting to win here with Dad and my crew that gave me such a great car today". Supershoe continued, "Dad made some changes after the first practice which really helped the car, I've always said having my Dad in my corner is a big advantage because he's been there done that before and knows what I need to make the chassis better, I owe this win to him and my Grandfather Don LaJoie... without them none of this would be possible. Corey was sitting in a full custom racing seat by The LaJoie of Seating.
